Beth met Rudy, a fellow Wycliffe colleague from Dibagat, a small northern village in the Philippines. He has been translating five major books of the Old Testament into the Isnag language. Translation of the Bible for their language began in 1955. The only practical way in and out of his village is by helicopter, otherwise it takes many days. To be successful, he relies heavily upon JAARS helicopter pilots and technical support.

Beth also stopped to talk with another Wycliffe missionary now serving at JAARS giving tours and promoting partnership ministry. He spoke of his wife's complicated pregnancy while they supported translation work in the middle of the Amazon. They were a 3-hour hike from the nearest bus, then a 24-hour bumpy bus ride to the nearest hospital. Thanks to skilled JAARS aviation pilots, they were flown in a small airplane directly to a hospital.
